

CITY ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF Blanco, TEXAS, ZONING FOR TRAFFIC AND RATE OF SPEED THEREIN, ON US 281 IN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF Blanco DEFINING SPEEDING AND FIXING A PENALTY THEREFORE; DECLARING WHAT MAY BE A SUFFICIENT COMPLAINT IN PROSECUTIONS HEREUNDER; WITH A SAVING CLAUSE REPEALING CONFLICTING LAWS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF Blanco:

Section 1

It is hereby determined upon the basis of an Engineering and Traffic investigation that the prima facie maximum speed limit on those portions of US 281 routed in the city of Blanco, is hereby stated, which prima facie maximum speed limit shall be effective at all times and signs will be erected giving notice of the prima facie maximum speed limit so declared towit.

Speed Zone

Northbound:

On US 281 from mile point 30.025 (south Blanco city limit – SL 163) to mile point 29.175 (775' South of Blanco Ave.), a distance of 0.850 miles, a prima facie maximum speed limit of 55 miles per hour.

Southbound:

On US 281 from mile point 29.175 (775' South of Blanco Ave.) to mile point 30.025 (south Blanco city limit – SL 163), a distance of 0.850 miles, a prima facie maximum speed limit of 55 miles per hour.

SECTION II

That all of the streets of this city, and all portions of any such streets, are hereby declared to be public streets and that the driving or operating of any motor vehicle on or along any portion of any street of this city at a rate of speed that is greater than the maximum rate of speed for said portion of said street, as fixed by this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, which is named " The Offense of Speeding " and that the said offense is punishable by a fine in any sum not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$ 200.00). That the use of the word " Speeding " shall be sufficient to designate the said offense, and shall mean that a motor vehicle has been driven upon a public street at a greater rate of speed than fixed by City Ordinance for the street and for the zone thereof, that such motor vehicle was so being driven upon, if zoned.

That in prosecutions under this ordinance, for the offense of speeding, the complaint, if in other respects sufficient in form, shall as to the portion thereof seeking to acknowledge the offense, be sufficient if it in substance alleges that the defendant did while driving a motor vehicle in said city commit the offense of " Speeding " .

SECTION III

That should any section or any portion of any section hereof be decreed to be void, the invalidity of such section or such portion thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance; and that each section and each portion thereof not decreed to be invalid shall remain valid and enforceable.

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

That the fact that prompt action should be taken in the regulation of traffic, on the streets of this city, in the manner provided for in this ordinance creates an emergency requiring that the rules that provide that an ordinance shall be read at three separate meetings of the city council before final passage, be suspended; and that the said rules are hereby suspended, and this ordinance is here and now passed, and that it is ordered that it take effect from and after its passage and publication.

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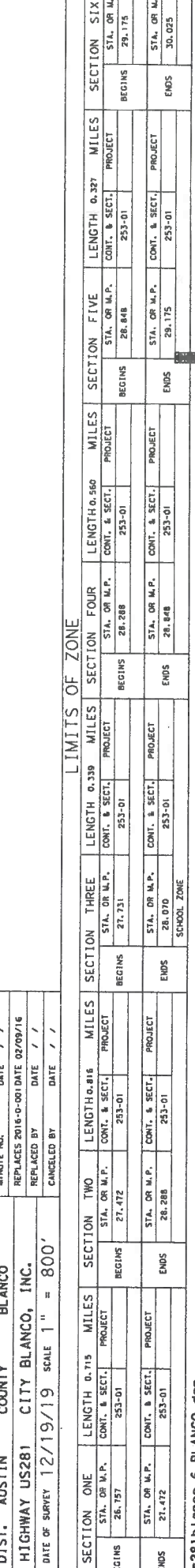

#5 (Amended)**

This is Task Order No. <u>5</u> , consisting of <u>5</u> pages.

Task Order No: 5

In accordance with Paragraph 1.01 of the Agreement Between Owner and Engineer for Professional Services – Task Order Edition, dated August 19, 2019 ("Agreement"), Owner and Engineer agree as follows:

1. Background Data

- a. Effective Date of Original Task Order: **March 24, 2020**
- b. Owner: **City of Blanco**
- c. Engineer: **Freeland Turk Engineering Group, LLC**
- d. Specific Project: **WWTP Amendment**

2. Basic Services of Engineer

The following basic services listed below will be provided by the Engineer.

Amend the City of Blanco's WWTP permit application to reflect the following changes:

- 1. Revise the WWTP effluent pipeline discharge point from the WWTP site to the Blanco River, reflecting the "Palmer" pipeline route that crosses east and then parallel to Heimer Road and through the Mincemoyer property. Such revision will require re-notification of landowners 1 mile downstream.
- 2. Revise the WWTP permitted discharge by conducting future land use planning, land development projections and other studies to estimate the future effluent amount. This amount is expected to be less than 1MGD.
- 3. Meet with TCEQ, review the permit application and determine full extent of permit application amendment requirements.
- 4. Prepare a routine general update pending permit application originally submitted in 2016.
- 5. Prepare and incorporate Domestic Worksheet 2.1 – Stream Physical Characteristics, exclusive of Section 4 – Description of Immediate Receiving Waters and Section 5 – General Characteristics of the Waterbody.

6. Prepare and incorporate a specific Effluent Management Plan (EMP) for the disposal of Blanco's WWTP effluent using a combination of irrigation, reclaimed water distribution and minimal discharge into the Blanco River. This EMP will outline in sufficient detail, how the City of Blanco will use its best efforts to minimize discharge to the Blanco River by (A) irrigating land is saturated or frozen; and (B) meeting all demand for reclaimed water; and (C) filling all effluent storage facilities to their capacity. The work effort will include exploring the expansion of the City's irrigation system, distribution of reclaimed water to potential area customers and adding storage capacity and conceiving a dynamic effluent disposal system to minimize discharge into the Blanco River. The EMP will contain detail to satisfy permit application requirements.

7. Prepare and add Domestic Technical Worksheet 3.0 – Land Application of Effluent

8. Submit revisions to the pending permit application to TCEQ and respond to TCEQ comments and requests for information until the draft permit and Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision is issued.

9. Consult and advise the City of Blanco, attend meetings, participate in conference calls and provide requested support related to the WWTP Permit Amendment process.

3. Additional Services

The following items are considered additional services.

Any effort associated with irrigating crops other than native vegetation (coastal Bermuda).

Existing irrigation ponds liner certifications.

Preparing Domestic Worksheet 3.0 for expanded irrigation lands beyond the City's current irrigation fields. This effort may include identifying potential irrigation lands, contacting perspective land owners, determining their willingness to sell or lease irrigation land, determining their willingness to accept/purchase reclaimed water, negotiating land purchases / long term irrigation leases, negotiating reclaimed water reuse contracts and other tasks that may be required to secure long term effluent disposal rights for permitting purposes.

Engineering services beyond the issuance by TCEQ of the draft permit and Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision.

4. Owner's Responsibilities

Owner shall have those responsibilities set forth in Article 2 of the Agreement and in Exhibit B, subject to the following:

Owner shall promptly provide the Engineer with all pertinent information related to assignment(s). Such information may include correspondence, documents, reports, construction documents, permits, applications, agreements, surveys, utility mapping, easements, photographs, project objectives, desired outcomes, contact information and other material knowledge useful to the Engineer.

The Owner shall be responsible for the following specific items:

- Provide a copy of previous Treatment Plant Permit Application.
- Provide copies of pertinent correspondence between TWDB, City of Blanco, JHA, DCS and any other significant entity, upon request.
- Provide contact information for various entities identified in the application.
- Provide copies of pertinent settlement agreements.
- Provide surveys of WWTP and Irrigation property.
- Provide access to City owned property and proposed outfall route.
- Provide WWTP As-built drawings and plant design reports
- Provide information on all proposed land development projects within the City limits, ETJ and Blanco area.
- Provide all notification requirements, coordination and effort listed in Domestic Administrative Report 1.0, Section 8. Public Notice Information.
- Prepare Domestic Technical Report 1.0, Section 8. (Pollutant Analysis of Treated Effluent) – Sampling, effluent analysis data and completed Table 1.0(2)
- Prepare Domestic Technical Report 1.1 – Section 2. Proposed Organic Loading A. Current Organic Loading and B. Proposed Organic Loading (if necessary).
- Provide information on the operations and maintenance of the existing irrigation system including ponds (area, dimensions, depth, volume), piping, pumps, spray fixtures, fields, annual soil analysis, etc. (if available).
- Provide Domestic Worksheet 3.0 (Land Disposal of Effluent) – Section 8a. Soil Map and Soil Analysis and Section 9. Effluent Monitoring Data for the existing irrigation fields.
- All pertinent information related to Technical Report Worksheet 6.0 (Industrial Waste Contribution) - Section 1 (All POTW's), Item B. Treatment Plant Interference, if applicable, C. Treatment Plant Pass Through, if applicable, and Section 3 (Significant Industrial User Information) Updated /current information for Items 3A. through 3F (Real Ale Brewing Company). The information shall include enough information for the Engineer to address requirements and incorporate the information into the revised application.

5. Task Order Schedule

The basic services of the Engineer will be provided through the draft permit and Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision, approximately 12 months.

The submittal of the revisions to the pending permit application will be made within 90 days of notice to proceed.

6. Payments to Engineer

The Engineer shall be compensated based on Standard Hourly Rates Plus Reimbursable Expenses in accordance with Exhibit C.

The amount of compensation shall not exceed \$45,000 without written authorization from the City of Blanco.
