## City of Blanco

## Committee for Financial Transparency and Security

<u>Authority</u>: It is serving the public welfare of the City of Blanco (the "city") and its citizens, the creation of a Committee for Financial Transparency and Security (the "Committee") is authorized.

<u>Creation & Duration</u>: The Committee may be created and disbanded by resolution of the governing body of the city. At creation, and from time to time, the governing body may impose specific conditions upon and charge the Committee with specific duties in addition to the general duties.

<u>General Duties</u>: The Committee shall review the city's accounting policies, procedures, and records to evaluate the financial operation and condition of the city and assess and identify any related, abnormal financial activity past or present. A written evaluation and assessment including any recommendations to revise current policies, and any discovered abnormal financial activity, its quantification, cause, and consequence, shall be provided to the mayor and governing body at the end of the review.

<u>Program of Work</u>: Prior to the commencement of any work, the Committee shall develop for the governing body's approval a program of work and governing rules or bylaws. The program shall be designed and implemented to reasonably accommodate the ordinary course of the city's operations and finance functions. The Committee shall periodically inform the mayor and governing body of its progress under the work program.

#### Composition & Nomination:

- a. The Committee shall be composed of eight members.
- b. Members of the Committee shall be nominated by the mayor and each member of the governing body, and are subject to approval by the governing body, as follows:
  - each member of the governing body shall each nominate one member of the Committee; and
  - 2) the mayor shall nominate three members of the Committee.

<u>Removal:</u> Any member of the Committee may be removed for any or no reason by an act of the governing body of the city.

<u>Qualifications</u>: All members of the Committee shall possess financial, accounting, business, non-profit, or government experience; provided, at least one member nominated by the mayor and one member nominated by the governing body shall possess significant financial or accounting experience of at least 10 years.

<u>Staffing</u>: The city's finance director shall serve as the Committee's primary staff liaison; provided, the mayor may appoint one additional staff co-liaison.

<u>Ex-Officio Members</u>: The mayor, each member of the governing body, city administrator, and city attorney shall be ex-officio members of the Committee and may participate in all Committee activities.

Open Government Requirements & Acknowledgement: All Committee proceedings, activities, records, and work product shall be conducted and held in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act (TOMA) and Public Information Act (PIA), and any other applicable law. All records and work products of the Committee shall be property of the City and held confidential, subject to the TOMA and PIA.

At the initial meeting of the Committee, and before work commences, each member of the Committee shall acknowledge the foregoing in writing, subject only to the TOMA, PIA and any other applicable law and as determined exclusively by the City, the Texas Attorney General or a state court of competent jurisdiction. Within thirty (30) days after appointment, each Committee member shall complete the state's mandatory online open government training and obtain the related certificate. Each Committee member shall also acknowledge in writing that that they are acting by and for the city and its citizens, and not in their individual capacities, and shall use any information obtained because of Committee service solely for such public purposes.
